Door to Door Service

We will collect you from home at the beginning of your holiday and return you to your home after your holiday. (Please check for details of this service). Please note some departures may involve early starts from home.

Flights

On all flights we include the cost of an allocated seat and one item of hold luggage. For the popular destinations in Europe we aim to offer flights from a London airport and also a northern airport, usually Manchester. Flights to long haul destinations usually fly from London. Also some European destinations only have flights from one UK airport and these may also require a London departure.

Due to airline schedules some flights may depart early morning. Although this means an early start, it also means you arrive earlier at your destination and can start to enjoy your holiday.

Accommodation

We use hotels that are at least to the UK standard of 3* and are often higher. The hotels are either checked by a member of CITO staff or agents acting on our behalf.

Meals

All holidays include full breakfast every day and most dinners (see individual holidays for details). On all river and ocean cruises breakfast, lunch and dinner are included. Also on all river cruises (except Springtime in the Heart of Paris), there is an inclusive drinks package covering drinks at the bar and with meals.

Excursions

All excursions detailed on individual itineraries are included together with admissions to attractions, boat trips and rail tickets. Some excursions involve walking and may be unsuitable for those with limited mobility. Please check before booking.

Overnight Stops

On some of the river cruises departing from the UK by coach, CITO are offering an overnight dinner bed and breakfast package at a hotel in the Kent area at the start of the holiday at a supplementary charge. Please ask if this is available from your local area.

Tour Manager

All of our holidays (except ocean cruises and Springtime in the Heart of Paris) are escorted by an experienced Tour Manager who will be with you throughout your holiday. The Tour Manager will travel with you from the UK or join you at your destination airport. Someone will always be available to greet and assist you at the departure airport.

We have appropriate financial protection in place to fully safeguard your money. Full details are available on request. All air tours and river cruises require a minimum deposit of £150 per person or 10% of the holiday whichever is the greatest. A deposit of 20% is required on all the ocean cruises.



23rd August 2017 | 10 days | £1295 per person

Explore the fascinating coastlines of the Emerald Isle. See the cliffs from the sea, the National Park from a jaunting car, kiss the Blarney Stone, Dart into Dublin – and so much more!

DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Dublin. A local coach will transfer us to the west coast where we will check into the Diamond Coast Hotel, Enniscrone our base for the next 3 nights. We will have dinner in the hotel.

DAY 2: After breakfast this morning, we travel north, following much of the coastline to the pretty town of Donegal. In the late morning we will enjoy a wonderful waterbus ride out into the bay to view the seal colony and the Bluestack Mountains with an interesting commentary on the way out and a fun sing-a-long on the way back. After some free time for lunch, we return to the hotel with a break in Sligo en-route.

DAY 3: Today we focus on Mayo as we follow sections of the coast road, via views of Downpatrick Head and Achill Island arriving at Westport in time for lunch. A little road train takes us for a visit to fascinating Westport House, rightly called the most beautiful house in Ireland. We return to the hotel via the enticing Foxford Woollen Mills.

DAY 4: We change location today as we enjoy the drive south towards County Kerry. We make a brief morning call into the pilgrimage village of Knock before we travel to Galway with free time for lunch. This afternoon we embark on the final leg of our journey to Tralee, arriving at the Earl of Desmond Hotel, our base for the next 3 nights. Dinner will be in the hotel this evening.

DAY 5: Today we are joined by a local guide for a full day as we explore some of the stunning highlights of the breathtaking Ring of Kerry, with photo and refreshment breaks along our route. We return via the Killarney National Park and experience a wonderful jaunting car ride through narrow lanes inaccessible to our coach. We will have a little free time in Killarney to end a wonderful day, before returning to our hotel for dinner.

DAY 6: "A load of ole Blarney" today as we travel to the popular city of Cork, with its centre located on an island in



the River Lee. After time here for a browse around and early lunch, we call at nearby Blarney Castle where you can explore at leisure and possibly venture up the tower to kiss that very lucky stone! We return to Tralee via an alternative route from the morning.

Discover the main ingredients of Italian life and their love of great food on this tour to glorious Tuscany. See the sights amidst some of Italy's most stunning landscapes and try your hand at the art of pasta making in an authentic country farmhouse, taking in the feast of the senses that is "la dolce vita".

DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Italy. A local coach will transfer us to the Hotel Manzoni, Montecatini Terme, our base for the next 7 nights.

DAY 2: This morning we visit a typical local farmhouse for our introduction to the tasty world of Italian cuisine. Learn how to prepare pasta, sauce, crostini and tiramisu, before we taste some local wine and olive oil. Having worked up an appetite, our morning ends with a typical Tuscan lunch of pasta and wine. This afternoon we meet our guide in Lucca for a tour of this charming town with its cathedral, Church of San Michele and well preserved city walls.

DAY 3: After breakfast today we visit Siena for a guided tour of this important medieval city. The highlight is the Piazza del Campo, the seashell-shaped square, on which the famous Palio horserace takes place each year. The imposing cathedral is a sight to behold. After time for lunch, we continue into the Chianti Valley, where the hilly landscape is interspersed with vineyards and palaces, we will stop to sample some wine.

DAY 4: We leave the coach behind today and take the train into Florence. Our local guide will meet us at the station and show us this beautiful Renaissance city. We will visit the Duomo de Santa Maria de Fiore, the Giotto Bell Tower and the historic district before some free time to admire the shops on the Ponte Vecchio, or to enjoy an Italian espresso, or a gelato.

DAY 5: Today we visit the medieval village of Vinci, birthplace of its most famous son, Leonardo da Vinci. We will visit the Museum of Leonardo and admire the models, which were constructed in accordance with his own drawings. He was truly years ahead of his time. We will also visit a coffee roaster and enjoy a chocolate tasting before we continue to the beautiful village of Lari, which enjoys an exquisite location in the hills of Pisa surrounded by cypress and olive groves.

DAY 6: You have the day at leisure today to explore Montecatini.

DAY 7: After breakfast we travel to Pisa to be charmed by this antique, former sea republic. We will see the impressive cathedral, the baptistery and of course, the world-famous Leaning Tower. After time for lunch, we continue to Versilia, the Tuscan seaside. Enjoy a little sightseeing in the Pietrasanta Marina, with its golden sand, it boasts one of the best beaches in Italy.

hotel on the Hardangerfjord from where we explore some of the best scenery in the country.

DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for our flight to Norway. A local coach will transfer us through beautiful scenery of the fjords and mountains to the Hotel Ullensvang, our base for the next 7 nights.

Cyprus - The Jewel of The Mediterranean

Standing at the crossroads of Europe, Asia and Africa, Cyprus has had a tumultuous history. Today its historic background merges with the natural beauty ranging from golden beaches to rugged coastlines to rolling hills and forest clad mountains, dotted with picturesque villages.

DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Cyprus. A local coach will transfer us to the Sentido Cypria Bay Hotel, our base for the next 9 nights

DAY 2: Today we enjoy a morning guided tour of the city of Paphos, once the ancient capital of Cyprus now emerging as one of the most popular resorts on the island. The city offers many attractions. We will visit Panagia Church, built in the 13th Century over the ruins of an early Byzantine basilica, it is believed that St Paul was flogged here by the Roman Governor. Afternoon free in Paphos.

DAY 3: After breakfast this morning, we depart on a full day guided excursion to the pine clad mountains of Troodos, dotted with picturesque villages. We visit the famous Kykkos Monastery, originally founded by the Byzantines in 1092 and is renowned for its wealth of frescoes and mosaics. Inside the church is the golden altar, the centrepiece of which is the famous icon of the Virgin. We continue to the village of Omodos, a wine producing village with a quaint cobblestone

DAY 4: Today you have a free day to relax and enjoy the sunshine, or perhaps take the bus into Paphos or onward to Coral Bay.

DAY 5: Today we enjoy a full day guided excursion to Nicosia, the capital city of Cyprus. We will see the Archbishop's Palace and visit the Cathedral of St John and also the Archaeological Museum and restored 19th Century Quarter. Lunch is included today in a local tavern.



Lake Maggiore is situated in the north west of Italy and crosses the border into Switzerland. The resort of Stresa is an ideal location on the shores of the Barromean Gulf. Once a tiny fishing village Stresa is now a bustling and vibrant town.

DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Italy. A local coach will transfer us to the Hotel Milan Speranza Au Lac, our base for the next 7 nights.

DAY 2: After breakfast our guide will take us on a morning tour of Stresa, which is sprinkled with villas, grand hotels and parks, and has a beautiful lakeside promenade with magnificent views over the lake. The afternoon is at leisure to explore further. The centre of Stresa has a good selection of cafes, traditional souvenir shops and boutiques. There is a cable car up Monte Mottarone with fantastic views over the lake to the Alps and beyond.

DAY 3: This morning we drive to the Franciacorta wine area to visit the gardens of Quistini Castle. A 16th Century residence, unique and filled with history, it is particularly famous for its enchanting and romantic park which offers more than 500 varieties of roses, hidden green corners and a secret hydrangea garden. We continue to the stunning Villa Visconti Borromeo Litta, known for its monumental nymphaeum and a series of symmetrically located rooms where the art collection of the family was displayed to welcome their guests.

DAY 4: Today we take a short boat ride to the Barromean Islands with admission to the Palace. The monumental Baroque palace and the majestic and scenic gardens have made the islands famous. The gardens contain many rare and exotic plants and the spectacular blossoming is planned to ensure that it is filled with colours and scents from March to October. Afternoon at leisure in Stresa.

DAY 5: After breakfast this morning we take a scenic drive into Switzerland to the town of Lugano which lies on the northern side of Lake Lugano and is surrounded by mountains offering splendid viewpoints. The traffic free historic town centre with its Mediterranean style squares and arcades

Think Corfu and you conjure up images of white-washed villages cascading down hillsides, azure seas sparkling in bright sunshine and powder-soft, white sand beaches. Corfu, the town, has a wealth Greek, French and British influences in its maze of cobbled streets and alleyways.

- An ascent of Mount Pilatus on the steepest funicular railway in the world. From the 7000ft summit there are amazing views to the surrounding mountains and down onto the city of Lucerne with the lake stretching into the distance. The descent to the suburbs of Lucerne is partly by a large cable car and partly by smaller gondola cable car.
- Cruise the full length of the lake from Lucerne to Fluelen.
 The trip takes just under 3 hours, during which the ship calls at several attractive lakeside villages. Wonderful mountain views all the way.
- By train to the resort of Engelberg at the base of Mount Titlis. From here we climb the mountain by gondola and rotating cable car to reach the summit at almost 10,000ft. At the top there are some of the best views in the Alps, as well as a cliff walk across Europe's highest suspension bridge, and the Ice Flyer chairlift which provides access to the Glacier Park.
- By boat to Vitznau to connect onto the world's oldest rack railway to climb to the summit on Mount Rigi. Here we have more spectacular views of Lake Lucerne with Mount Pilatus on the far side. After time to take one of the many walks, including a short one to the summit, we descend by another rack railway on the other side of the mountain to Arth-Goldau and then by train to Lucerne and Hergiswil.

We will use a Regional Pass to take advantage of the best that the system has to offer.

DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Switzerland. A coach will transfer us to Aeschi Park Hotel, our base for the next 9 nights.

DAYS 2 TO 9: On six of the days our Tour Manager will lead us on excursions using the public transport system. Each day will start on the local bus to Spiez station from where we continue by train, mountain railway and lake steamer.

- By bus and train to the town of Thun with free time to explore the historic central area before taking a boat the full length of Lake Thun to the international resort of Interlaken. We will have time to wander along the Hohweg with its grand hotels on one side and views to the Eiger, Monch and Jungfrau mountains on the other.
- Travel by funicular railway at a gradient of up to 1 in 1.4 to the top of the Niesen Mountain. From the top (7,750ft) there are spectacular views down onto Lake Thun and across the mountain slopes to Aeschi. After time at the top we descend to the valley and join a conventional train which climbs up the Kander Valley to the resort of Kandersteg. After a break we join a narrow gauge train for a scenic journey over the Brunig Pass and along the shore of Lake Brienz to Interlaken.

- To Interlaken where we join a boat for a trip on Lake Brienz through outstanding scenery to the village of Brienz. Here we change to the rack railway for an ascent up the Brienzer Rothorn Mountain (7,700ft). Wonderful views from the top across to the Eiger, Monch and Jungfrau mountains and down onto the whole expanse of Lake Brienz.
- Via Interlaken to Wilderswil where we change onto the rack railway to the Schynige Platte at the edge of a mountain ridge. After time at the top we descend to the valley floor and return to Interlaken from where we join the Harder Funicular to travel up to Harder Kulm with its great views down onto the town and the mountains beyond.
- Today takes takes us to the highest railway station in Europe at Jungfrajoch. We start by travelling through Spiez and Interlaken to Lauterbrunnen where the climbing really starts. Our narrow gauge train heads up the side of the valley to reach the mountain resort of Wengen and then continues to Kleine Scheidegg where we change to the Jungfrau Railway. At last we reach Junfraujoch, the 'Top of Europe' at 11,330ft. On a clear day the views over the Alps are stunning. We have time to enjoy the attractions and have lunch before descending via Kleine Scheidegg to the mountain resort of Grindelwald and back to Aeschi.

There will be two free days during which your travel passes will be valid. On the first, your Tour Manager will escort those who wish to the mountain village of Murren above the Lauterbrunnen Valley. There will be various options before the return journey to Aeschi including an ascent of the cable car to the top of the Schilthorn (supplement payable). The other free day will enable you to visit a variety of other scenic destinations or return to somewhere you have particularly liked earlier in the holiday.

DAY 10: We travel by coach back to Zurich Airport for our flight back to the UK then Door to Door service home.

Based on Lake Lucerne

A new Alpine holiday for the late winter where we travel across snowy Central Switzerland. We use mountain rail and cableways to get up into the snow to see the magnificent scenery of the area. Our base will be at Hergiswil on the shore of Lake Lucerne.



DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Switzerland. From here we shall travel by coach to our base for the next 7 nights - the Seehotel Pilatus in the village of Hergiswil.

After enjoying the views and having time for lunch we return to Interlaken for some free time and then back over the Brunig Pass to Hergiswil.

DAY 4: Another day of mountain climbing with plenty of snow. We head south from Lucerne by train to climb the historic main Gotthard line to reach Goschenen. Here we change onto a steep rack railway to climb through the Schollenen Gorge to Andermatt – a winter sports resort surrounded by mountains. The village is also on the route of the famous Glacier Express and so we will take a short ride on this line to get to the top of the Oberalp Pass at 6,700ft. This is a very popular skiing area. We return to Hergiswil by

DAY 5: A free day but your local travel pass will be valid on trains, buses and mountain railways. Some may want to spend the day at Lucerne but there are plenty of other areas to explore including an ascent of Mount Pilatus by cable car. DAY 6: Today we head east on the Voralpen Express past Lake Zug and then up onto a snowy plateau to reach Einsiedeln – Switzerland's most popular pilgrimage site. It has an impressive baroque monastery and cathedral with its large ceiling frescoes and Chapel of Grace. The town is also a popular winter sports resort.

DAY 7: Our last journey takes us by train to the resort of Engelberg at the base of Mount Titlis. From here we climb the mountain firstly by gondola and then by a rotating cable car to reach the summit at almost 10,000ft. At the top there are some of the best views in the Alps as well as a cliff walk across Europe's highest suspension bridge and the Ice Flyer chairlift which provides access to the Glacier Park. DAY 8: We travel by coach back to the airport for our flight back to the UK then Door to Door service home.

Apart from the charter coach from and back to the airport, all our travelling in Switzerland will be by scheduled public transport. Hergiswil station is around a ten minute walk from our hotel. 



Good quality hotels throughout with breakfast every morning and dinner on all but two nights. This tour has more meals and attractions included than offered by many other tour operators. DAY 1: Your Door to Door service will transfer you to Heathrow Airport for an overnight flight to Johannesburg. DAY 2: On arrival at Johannesburg Airport we transfer to a connecting flight to Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe where we will be met and taken to the Victoria Falls Safari Lodge where we stay for two nights. This luxurious hotel overlooks a watering hole where a variety of game animals come to drink. Our rooms and the restaurant take advantage of this wonderful view. The rest of the day will be at leisure to take advantage of the hotel's facilities. D

DAY 3: This morning, after a leisurely breakfast, we enjoy a guided tour of Victoria Falls known locally as the 'Smoke that Thunders'. Here, the Zambezi River plummets 360ft into a chasm almost a mile wide. Late afternoon we set out for an amazing sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi River including light refreshments before returning to our hotel for dinner. BD DAY 4: This morning is at leisure before we transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for a lunchtime flight to Johannesburg. On arrival we will be met by our South African guide who will be with us for the rest of the tour. We transfer by coach to the Southern Sun Katherine Street Hotel in Sandton. BD **DAY 5:** Today we drive to Pretoria to visit the Voortrekker Monument followed by a city tour including Church Square and the impressive Union Buildings. We continue into the Mpumalanga area, descending several hundred feet into the subtropical region of the Lowveld. We travel via the historic towns of Witbank, Dullstroom and Lydenburg to reach our hotel situated on the Long Tom Pass from where there are glorious views over the surrounding countryside. BD DAY 6: Today our first stop will be at the old mining village of Pilgrim's Rest which has been preserved as a heritage site.

Then head north to the Blyde River Canyon, an amazing 20mile long 2,300 foot deep gorge cutting through the Great Escarpment. We visit the Three Rondavels, God's Window and the Bourke's Luck Potholes before arriving at the town of Graskop. We then proceed to Hazyview, where we have time to relax at our hotel before a short transfer for dinner and a cultural show at the Shangaan River Club. B, PACKED L, D DAY 7: At dawn, we depart for a day of game viewing in the Kruger National Park. We trade in the coach for specially modified 4x4 open safari vehicles, with experienced game rangers, and go in search of Africa's 'Big 5'. We should at least see lions, baboons, giraffe, hippos, rhinos, elephants, crocodiles and hopefully more besides. There will be regular stops at rest camps with full facilities. We return to our hotel in Hazyview mid-afternoon with the rest of the day free to enjoy the hotel's amenities. BD

DAY 8: Today, we leave Mpumalanga and travel south into the tiny kingdom of Swaziland. We will enter through the Matsamo border crossing and drive through the beautiful Highveld to Piggs Peak. After a stop at the Ngwenya Glass Village and the Swazi Candle Factory we will arrive at the Royal Swazi Spa Hotel in the Ezulwini Valley for the night. DAY 10: We drive to the Battlefields where we spend time exploring this historically rich region. Our first stop is at Isandlwana, the site of a battle where 20,000 Zulu warriors took on the firepower of the British Army and defeated an entire regiment in around two and a half hours. After lunch at the Isandlwana Lodge we visit Rorke's Drift, where a handful of British soldiers, outnumbered 35 to 1, fought off 4,000 Zulus in a 12 hour battle which saw 11 Victoria Crosses awarded, the highest number ever awarded in a single action. A local battlefields expert will explain the stages of both battles in graphic detail. **BLD**

DAY 11: After breakfast we drive back to Johannesburg Airport from where we take an internal flight to Port Elizabeth. On arrival we have a short tour of this attractive city before reaching our hotel overlooking the beach. **BD**

DAY 12: Today we drive through increasingly beautiful scenery to reach the Garden Route. We travel through the Tsitsikamma Forest and make a stop at Storms River Mouth with time to relax by the shore, or take a walk along the base of the cliffs to the pedestrian bridge which spans the mouth of the river. Then travel through the resort of Plettenburg Bay, stopping for lunch on the way. In the afternoon we visit the Knysna Elephant Park, a home for abandoned and orphaned elephants before heading to Knysna at the centre of the Garden Route. Kloof Gorge and enter the Breede River Valley winegrowing area. We continue up the valley to Worcester and then travel through the Huguenot Tunnel to reach the Cape Winelands. Before reaching our hotel we visit the Van Ryn brandy distillery for a tour and tasting. We will spend the night on the famous wine estate at Spier near Stellenbosch. BD DAY 16: After breakfast, we will tour the renowned Cape Winelands. Our day will include a stroll through the historic town of Stellenbosch, a drive across the scenic Helshoogte Pass, two wine tastings and a cellar tour. The vineyards are immaculately laid out and most have historic buildings to view and all with a backdrop of beautiful mountain scenery. Lunch is included at the renowned Boschendal Estate. Later we drive into Cape Town for a three night stay at our hotel which is within walking distance of Victoria and Alfred Waterfront which is full of shops, restaurants and bars. This afternoon there will be an optional tour by boat to Robben Island to tour this former notorious prison where Nelson Mandela was held for 23 years. Those wishing not to take this optional excursion can have more time to enjoy the Waterfront or return to the hotel for a relaxing afternoon. Dinner is not included this evening but there is a huge choice of restaurants in the V&A Waterfront adjacent to our hotel. B DAY 18: Today, see the spectacular southern peninsula, known as the 'Fairest Cape'. We drive through Camps Bay and Llandudno – millionaire's paradise, enjoy a Seal Island Cruise from Hout Bay, drive over Chapman's Peak and visit the resident penguin colony at Boulder's Beach and the naval town of Simonstown. We enjoy lunch at Bertha's Restaurant. After lunch we continue into Table Mountain National Park to visit the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point where a short funicular ride will take us to the famous view point. Then back to the V&A Waterfront with free time for lunch and last minute shopping before being transferred to Cape Town International Airport for our overnight flight to London via Johannesburg. B

Later we reach Punakaika on the edge of the Paporoa National Park to view rugged coastline and the famous 'Pancake Rocks' and blowholes. DAY 20: A highlight of the tour as we drive to Milford Sound along one of the most scenic roads in the world through the Southern Alps. Before reaching Milford Sound we shall have a picnic lunch in the coach. At our destination we take to the water for a scenic cruise through the fjord which stretches 22km to the Tasman Sea. This Fair Trading Agreement sets out clearly and simply the responsibilities which we have to you and in turn you have to us when a contract is made between us.

The contract is made when you make a booking and we accept it by written confirmation on the terms set out in

our publicity material. When signing the Booking Form for your holiday you will sign on behalf of yourself and the others named in your party that you have read, understood and have accepted this Trading Charter, holiday information provided in the brochure and Contract. Your obligation is to pay the price of the

holiday and recognise your liabilities if you wish to alter the holiday or have to make a cancellation. On our part we have obligations to provide you with the holiday that you have booked. Our specification of that holiday and our terms are clearly stated in our publicity material. All bookings are accepted on these conditions.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Your contract is with CITO Limited 'the Company' which is licensed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) under Air Transport Organiser's Licence (ATOL) 6218. The Company offices are at Monkswell Business Centre, Manse Lane, Knaresborough, HG5 8NQ. The Registered Number is 03859958.

1. BOOKING AND PAYMENT

When you make your booking you must complete a booking form, accepting on behalf of all your party the terms of these booking conditions and pay a deposit indicated in the brochure. All monies paid to your travel agent are held by him on your behalf until we issue our confirmation invoice. There after your travel agent holds the monies on our behalf. A contract will exist when we issue our confirmation invoice. The balance of the price of your holiday must be paid at least 8 weeks (for River Cruise holidays 10 weeks, for Sea Cruises 16 weeks) before your departure date. If the balance is not paid in time we reserve the right to cancel your holiday, retain your deposit, and apply the cancellation charges set out in paragraph 3 below. cancellation charges set out in paragraph 3 below.

2. IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING

If, after our confirmation has been issued, you wish to change to another of our holidays or change departure date, we will do our utmost to make the changes, provided that notification is received in writing at our offices from the person who signed the booking form, or from their travel agent, at least 4 weeks before departure. This must be accompanied by a payment of £25 to cover our administration costs. Alterations cannot be made within 4 weeks of departure and any such request for an alteration will be treated as a cancellation of the original booking and will be subject to the cancellation charges set out in paragraph 3 below.

3. IF YOU CANCEL YOUR HOLIDAY

You, or any member of your party, may cancel your holiday at any time provided that the cancellation is made by the person signing the booking form and is communicated to us in writing via the office at which you made your original booking. You will have to pay cancellation charges to cover our administration costs and to compensate for the risk of us not being able to resell the holiday. Your cancellation will take effect from the date on which either our agent or we receive your written confirmation of your cancellation. You must also return any tickets or vouchers that you have received. A reduction in room occupancy may increase the charges for the remaining passengers by the application of supplements for low occupancy of rooms. Cancellation charges will be applied as per the scale shown.

Where bought in supplies, such as flights, cruise, ferries, hotel accommodation etc, have been bought in on your behalf, and under the terms and conditions of the supplier are non-refundable, these products will be charged out at the full retail rate. If this applied the non-refundable items will be deducted from you holiday costs and the following scale of charges will be applied to the remainder:

You can transfer your booking to someone else provided you

give us reasonable notice. This person must be able to satisfy all the conditions for the holiday and a change cannot normally be made later than 14 days prior to departure. We will make an administration charge of £25 per booking per person for every transfer we make plus any additional costs caused by the transfer. You will remain responsible for ensuring that the holiday is paid for by the balance due date. However if the booking contains elements that are not transferable e.g. Airline tickets it will not be possible.

4. IF YOU HAVE A COMPLAINT

If you have a problem during your holiday, please inform your Tour Manager or the relevant supplier/resort representative immediately who will endeavour to put things right. If your complaint cannot be completely resolved locally, you must complete a report form which can be obtained from your Tour Manager or local representative. It is therefore a condition of this contract that you communicate any problem to the supplier of the services in question AND to our representative whilst in resort and obtain a written report form. If you fail to follow this simple procedure we cannot accept responsibility as we have been deprived of the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem.

5. SURCHARGE POLICY

Holiday prices include all travel, hotel accommodation and meals as specified in the holiday description and VAT payable in the UK where applicable. The price of the holiday will not be subjected to any surcharges except those arising from currency surcharges, transportation including fuel (including fuel tax), air & ferry operator fares and tolls, embarkation or disembarkation fees at terminals, duties and taxes (including the rate of VAT). Even in these cases we will absorb the cost equivalent to the cost of first 2% of the holiday price. Amounts in excess of this plus £5 administration fee and Travel Agents commission will be surcharged to you. If this means the total cost of the holiday increases by more than 10% then you are entitled to cancel your holiday and receive a full refund of all monies paid except any insurance premium and amendment charges. If you exercise the right to cancel we must receive written notice within 14 days of the date of the surcharge invoice. The currency exchange rate used in the holiday costings are based on rates as at 10th July 2015. In addition to sterling we use the following currencies in calculating our holiday prices. 6. ALTERATION OR CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

Important Note: Compensation will not be payable if we are forced to cancel or in any way change your holiday due to war, threat of war, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions or other circumstances amounting to force majeure.

We reserve the right in any circumstances to cancel your holiday and all holidays operate subject to a minimum number of participants. If any part is not provided as promised, we will pay you appropriate compensation if this has affected your enjoyment of your holiday.

We accept responsibility for the acts and/or omissions of our employees, agents and suppliers except where they lead to death, injury or illness. Our liability in all cases shall be limited to a maximum of twice the value of the original holiday cost. We accept responsibility for death, injury, or illness caused by the negligent acts and/or omissions of our employees or agents together with our suppliers and sub-contractors, servants and/or agents of the same whilst acting within the scope of, or in the course of their employment in the provision of your holiday. We will accordingly pay to our clients such damages as might have been awarded in such circumstances under English Law.

In respect of carriage by air, sea, tunnel and rail and the provision of accommodation our liability in all cases will be limited in the manner provided by the relevant international convention.

If any client suffers death, illness or injury whilst overseas arising out of an activity which does not form part of the foreign inclusive holiday arrangement or excursion arranged through us, we shall, at our discretion offer advice, guidance and assistance to help you in resolving any claim you may have against a third party, provided we are advised of the incident within 90 days of the occurrence. Where legal action is contemplated our authority must be obtained prior to commencement of proceedings and be subject to your undertaking to assign any costs recovered or any benefits

received under an appropriate insurance policy to ourselves. Our costs in respect of the above on behalf of you and your party shall not exceed £5,000 in total.

When you travel with the carrier, the conditions of carriage of that carrier apply, some of which may limit liability. This brochure is the responsibility of the tour operator; it is not issued on behalf of, and does not commit the airlines mentioned therein or any airline whose services are used in the course of the tour.

8. INSURANCE

It is a condition of contract that you take out personal travel insurance. You may use an alternative insurer but you must advise us of the name of the insurer, policy number and 24 hour contact number on your booking form. The level of cover must be at least equal to that provided above.

10. PASSPORT

14. SPECIAL REQUESTS AND DIETS

18. CONSUMER PROTECTION
